Enrollment for 2020-2021

Resident Boundary Students

If you live within Paul Revere Charter Middle School boundaries, beginning March 2, 2020, you will need to bring proof of residency (a current gas or electric bill) to the Attendance office to obtain an enrollment packet. Enrollment packets for resident students must be submitted in person to the Attendance Office by the parent/guardian by May 15, 2020 for priority enrollment.

Enrollment will start with prospective students who reside within the attendance boundaries of Paul Revere Charter Middle School (“resident students”). They shall have ***first*** admission preference and thus are deemed exempt from the lottery.

Lottery Applications for Non-Resident Students

If you do not live within the Revere’s boundaries but would like to apply for our Charter Lottery, please see the information below.

As an Affiliated Charter, Paul Revere Charter Middle School follows LAUSD’s Unified Enrollment process and deadlines for non- resident applicants. If there is more interest than the number of spaces available, a random public lottery will be conducted for non-resident boundary students as described below.

Revere Charter’s non-resident lottery applications, **INCLUDING SIBLINGS of currently enrolled students who live outside of Revere’s boundaries** will be made available each year through the On-Time LAUSD Unified Enrollment process (Choices Brochure & Application and GoTo.Lausd.Net). **The six- week on-time application window is from October 1, 2019 - November 15, 2019 at 5pm.**

Lottery Preferences and Procedures

In conducting its admissions lottery, Revere Charter MS shall provide the following admission preferences, in the stated order of priority:

LAUSD Students

- Siblings - Prospective students who (a) are siblings of students enrolled in grades 6-7 at Revere Charter Middle School at the time of the lottery and (b) reside within LAUSD boundaries, but not within the attendance boundaries of Revere Charter MS, shall have ***second*** admission preference.
- Other LAUSD Students - All other prospective students who reside within LAUSD boundaries, but not within the attendance boundaries of Revere Charter Middle School, shall have ***third*** admission preference.

California Students (outside of LAUSD boundaries)

- Siblings - Prospective students who (a) are siblings of students enrolled in grades 6-7 at Revere Charter MS at the time of the lottery and (b) reside in the State of California but not within LAUSD boundaries, shall have *fourth* admissions preference.
- Prospective students who reside in the State of California but not within LAUSD boundaries, shall have *fifth* admissions preference.

Students who participate in the lottery but are not selected for admission during the lottery shall be placed on a waitlist in the same priority order as above. As seats become available, Revere Charter MS shall fill the seats from the waitlist. This waitlist shall be effective until the end of the programmatic year to which it pertains.

During the month of February, after receiving the list of interested applicants from Unified Enrollment, Revere Charter Middle School will conduct its public random drawing (lottery) for non-resident boundary students only, if applicable.

Revere Charter Middle School will hold its lottery in the auditorium, on **Wednesday, February 26, 2020 at 9:00am**. Any interested party or member of the public may attend, but attendance is not required to participate in the lottery.

Parents of applicants being offered admission through the lottery will be notified in writing by email or mail, depending on the method of application submission within one month following the lottery, and will be provided three weeks to accept the offered seat.

Parents of student applicants who are placed on the waitlist resulting from the lottery may call the school to find out their child's priority number on the waitlist. Parents of student applicants on the waitlist who are offered admission at any time subsequent to the lottery will receive notification by email or telephone call. After three contacts are attempted with no return call, Revere Charter MS will consider this an automatic decline.

Non-resident boundary students who apply for admission after the On-Time application window will be added to the bottom of the waitlist in the order in which their applications are received. Choices Late Applications are processed on a first come, first-served basis beginning February 1, 2020 through norm day of the following school year.

Revere Charter MS will contact waitlisted and late applicants. There is no need to call the office to find out if your child has been offered a spot.
