Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Genesis Golf Tournament will begin on Tuesday, February 12 and end Sunday, February 17. The campus of Paul Revere will be used for tournament parking during this week allowing the Riviera Country Club to continue to host one of Los Angeles's historic, time tested sporting events.

Please bear with us during this busy week. Traffic will be heavy all over the neighborhood, especially on Sunset Boulevard, San Vicente Boulevard, and Allenford Avenue. Visitors to the Open will begin to arrive at 5:00am daily. **Tournament only parking will use the west gate. The west driveway will be closed for the week; no access to Sunset/Mandeville will be available.** We ask that if you plan to drop off or pick up students that you do so using the horse shoe driveway in the front of the school or from some nearby location, as **entering and leaving the campus in the morning and afternoon will not be possible.** The horseshoe driveway will be closed for pick-up until 3:15pm (W, F), 2:15pm (T, Th), please keep this in mind when scheduling your week. The East gate will be for faculty and staff access only. **No student drop off or pick up will be allowed through either gate.**

In addition, Los Angeles City Parking Enforcement has informed Revere that for the week of the Tournament February 13-17, no one will be allowed to stop on Allenford Avenue to pick up or drop off students. Limited parking on both sides of Brinkley St. will be permitted for pick up and drop off.

All afterschool activities including PEP and Tutoring will be canceled, only Beyond the Bell will continue to be open in the GYM. Parents who regularly pick up their children at the end of the school day in the Horseshoe drive should do so within thirty minutes of dismissal. Revere has limited ability to supervise students on campus after the close of the school day. All school offices will officially close at 4:30pm. There will be no adults regularly available to assist students on campus during this tournament week after 4:30pm, all offices will be vacated. Before 4:30pm, students waiting for pick up, will be directed to remain on the grassy area in front of the auditorium by the flagpole. Please pick up your child by driving into the circular driveway in front of the school before 4:30pm. Be advised that school is closed in observance of Presidents Day the Monday following the tournament.

Thank you for your support and cooperation during Revere's important annual community event.
