You will also learn about Horticulture: the parts and functions of plants, gardening skills,

_____ **PHOTOSHOP/iMOVIE:** Students are taught the basic tools and skills of Photoshop CS4 using the iMac lab. They create projects throughout the year to develop logical thinking and inspire creativity.

_____ **DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHY:** Learn about taking pictures and using a digital single lens reflex (DSLR) camera. Learn the basics about film speed, aperture, and shutter speed.

_____ **GENERAL ART:** Learn drawing basics and color theory. Focus is on 2D skills and multicultural projects. Express your creativity through mediums such as charcoal, paint, computer graphics, collage and other traditional materials.
