We are pleased to announce that on Wednesday, October 16, 2019, Paul Revere Middle School will administer the PSAT 8/9 to ALL 8th students.

The test will be administered for the duration of 2 hours and 50 minutes with scheduled breaks. We strongly encourage all of our students and families to make all efforts to arrive on time to Homeroom period of the date of the test. **No make-up testing will be offered.**

The PSAT 8/9, which is tightly aligned with SAT and PSAT/NMSQT, establishes a baseline for college and career readiness knowledge for our students and families, along with the additional benefits listed below:

- Personalized online score report including detailed information about your child's strengths and areas for growth, identifying where they excel and where they can improve to be ready for college
- Score report with each student's comprehensive, personalized feedback on test performance, allowing students to see which questions were answered incorrectly and which academic skills they should work to improve
- Personalized practice on Khan Academy allowing students the opportunity to upload their test results to receive targeted learning plans that students can use to learn more about and practice the skills they need to improve
- Allows students to explore college majors and careers that align with personal interests with *Roadmap to Careers*, a unique online tool created by RoadTrip Nation to connect students to potential careers
- Possible identification of specific AP courses your child has the potential to do well in during high school, as taking even one AP class is a great way to show potential colleges academic strengths
- The PSAT 8/9 tests the same skills and knowledge as the SAT, PSAT/NMSQT, and PSAT 10- in a way that makes sense for each grade level.
