Salvador B. Castro (October 25, 1933 – April 15, 2013) was a Mexican-American educator and activist. He was most well known for his role in the 1968 East Los Angeles high school walkouts, a series of protests against unequal conditions in Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) schools. Although he retired, he continued to lecture about his experiences and the importance of education, especially for Mexican Americans.

Castro was born in Los Angeles and began kindergarten at Belvedere Elementary School in East Los Angeles, but moved to Mexico when his father was forcibly repatriated during the "Repatriation Movement". Returning to East L.A. while still in grade school, he experienced discrimination for speaking Spanish in the classroom. After graduating from a Catholic high school, he was drafted into the Army but never saw combat. He earned his BA at CSU LA and was later hired at Belmont High to teach Social Studies.

Castro advocated for the rights of Mexican-American students and coached students to take student government positions. In 1968, the curriculum largely ignored or denied Mexican American history. To protest rampant prejudice and improve public education, Mexican-American students organized a series of mass walkouts throughout East Los Angeles and Castro walked out with them.

In 2010 when a school was renamed Salvador B. Castro Middle School, several years ago, he said, "I know that by naming a school after me you are really honoring the students who, more than four decades ago, tried to improve education with their courageous walkouts."

All students will be taking district assessments (about 20 minutes each) in ELA and MATH the week of October 26 during Homeroom Advisory.

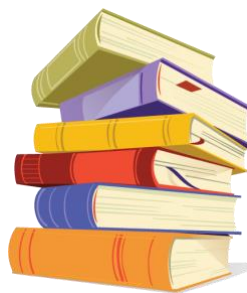
Monday October 26 – Thursday October 29, Homeroom Advisory students will meet together for the assessment. One Zoom link will be provided to students by their Advisory teacher.

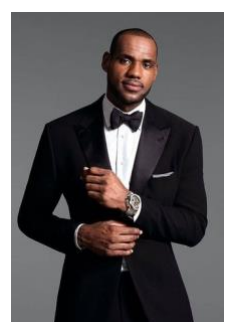
