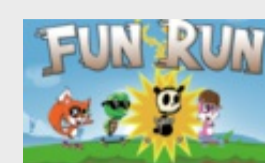
**Palisades Optimist International Oratorical Contest**

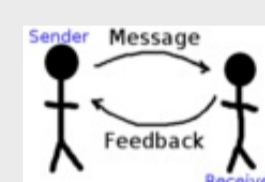
