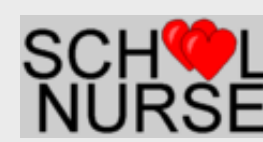

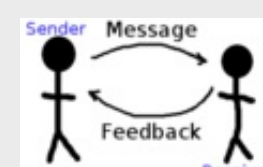
Ready... Set... Revere!
