Pali High Baseball Tryouts

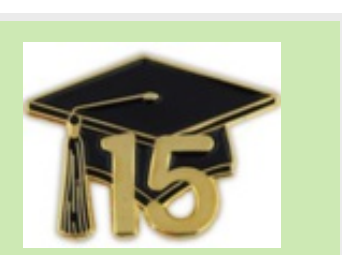

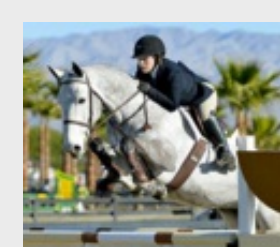

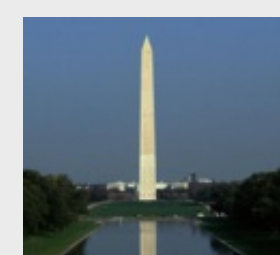
The next 8th Grade Activities Meeting is on Friday, May 8 at 8:00 am in the Teacher's Lounge.

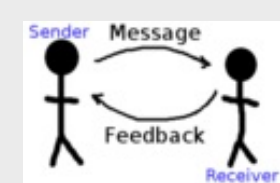
Interscholastic Equestrian League
