Sonia Maria Sotomayor is an Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of the United States. She was nominated by President Barack Obama, confirmed by the Senate by a vote of 68-31 and has served since 2009. Sotomayor is the first Hispanic and Latina member of the Court.

Sotomayor was born in the projects in the Bronx, New York City, to Puerto Rican-born parents. Her father, a factory worker, died when she was nine, and she was subsequently raised by her mother, a nurse. Books were her solace. Her parents instilled in her a belief in the power of education. Driven by an indefatigable work ethic, and rising to the challenge of managing a diagnosis of juvenile diabetes, Sotomayor excelled in school. Sotomayor graduated from Princeton University in 1976 and received her law degree from Yale Law School in 1979.



During her tenure on the Supreme Court, Sotomayor has been identified with concern for the rights of defendants, calls for reform of the criminal justice system, and making impassioned dissents on issues of race, gender and ethnic identity
